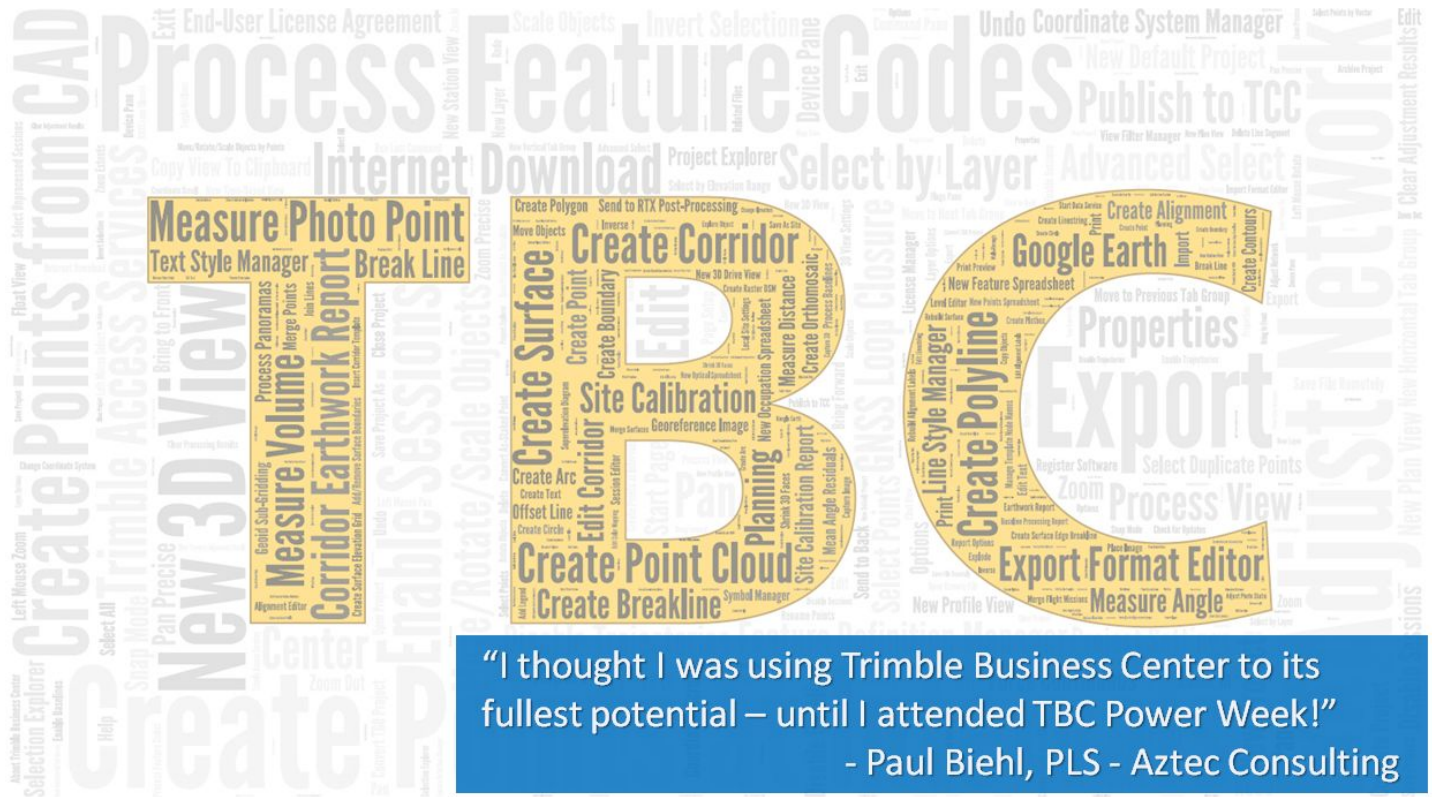


# Raunheim TBC Power Week Announcement



Building on the tremendous success of the TBC Power Week events in the United States, we are pleased to invite our TBC users to apply for the first TBC Power Week in Europe. It will be hosted at Trimble's office in **Raunheim, Germany, November 4th - 7th, 2019**. The attendees will be immersed in an intense hands-on experience with TBC, sharing experience and knowledge with other participants along the way. The TBC Power Week is limited to 25 people and we will use a random selection process to select the final participants if more than 25 people apply.

## Who is this user event for?

This event is for TBC **end users** with intermediate-to-advanced software skills who are looking to expand their knowledge of TBC. Although it is hosted in Germany, **English** will be used throughout the event.

## Application Timeline

The application deadline is Friday, **September 27th, 2019**. We will notify the selected participants by Friday, October 4th, 2019, allowing four weeks for you to arrange and prepare for travel. If you don't get a chance to participate in person, we will make an effort to follow-up with you and you can be considered for additional events.

## Application Process

Attendees will be provided with further details and logistics as well as some getting started information prior to the Power Week. It is expected that attendees have the latest TBC version installed and licensed. Datasets and presentations will be provided ahead of time and attendees should have it readily available at the start of the Power Week.
